GENERAL RULES AND COMMENTS

MEALS

REQUIRED OF ALL WHO EAT AT CAMP: You must help setting up and cleaning up – your assignments and schedule are on the back of the brochure.

All meals served family style. **BE ON TIME.** Enter the dining room and be seated – otherwise you are in the way of those setting up and serving. Prayer and announcements will be made. We are expected to assist the camp staff in setting up, serving and cleaning of the dining room. Each table is to appoint two servers for each meal.

CABINS/CURFEWS

Please be considerate of your cabin roommates. Keep noise and disruption to a minimum. Young children (and those not so young) need their sleep. **IN ROOMS BY 10:30PM; lights out by 11:00pm. Every person should be in their assigned cabin at 11:00PM. (Remember 7:30 AM is breakfast!!!)**

CLEANING

Please leave cabins in a neat and orderly appearance. Remove all belongings before 1:00 PM Sunday. A check list in each cabin must be completed before we leave. Empty trash cans in outside bins. We would like to leave the camp in as good or better condition as when we arrived!

Many helpers make light work. Sunday afternoon volunteers are needed to help clean dining hall, Iroquois Bldg and general camp clean up. Please see one of these brethren: Andrew Fraser, Dave Fertig or Bob Kling, if you can help out.

PARENTS/GUARDIAN RESPONSIBILITIES: ATTENDANCE

You are responsible for supervision of your children and charges during non-scheduled time periods. Children under 12 should not be left unsupervised. (It is hunting season!)

Please advise the teacher if a child will not be attending a scheduled activity or class.

Children or teens are expected to be in all classes, Sat PM program and at Sunday meeting. Children are not to be wandering around the camp during these times.

Please encourage good manners at the snack tables during refreshment times and proper behavior with sticks and marshmallows at the campfire!!!
